Our goal is to equip women with the skills and support necessary to maintain lifelong sobriety and become self-supportive, productive members of society through employment, working a 12-step Christ-centered program while living in a Christian environment.



Blessing The Muehleisens



For 27 years John and Beth Muehleisen have followed God's call. They have lived and ministered in East Africa where they worked very closely with the African church. These years were devoted to discipling and training Africans to live Christ-like lives as they reached out to others with the good news of Jesus Christ. In the past three years they have been World Gospel Missions global headquarters in Indiana developing new resources for missionaries and helping in the department of human resources so that staff can flourish wherever God calls them. Even though they are now based at headquarters, they are still on missionary status. This means they must raise their own missionary support just like they did while living in Africa.

McEachern has been honored to partner with the Muehleisens during all of their service. In December they let supporters know that they had a \$20,000 shortfall in support mainly because many long-term supporters had passed away. They also mentioned they would need 40 new supporters willing to give \$50 a month to move into the future. In January your Mission Lead Team was moved to show them MMUMC's complete support for their mission. With God's guidance, we voted to send them a check for \$25,000 to relieve their 2022 shortfall and to give them breathing room as they find new supporters. They were joyful to receive these funds and praised God for His quick answer to their prayers.

This great gift was possible because of your giving to Faith Promise. Please pray for John and Beth as they continue to mentor Christian Leaders at home and abroad.

Korytskyi Family Update


