

Register & Pay On-Line at McEachernumc.org under "Events" or "Church Life." We must have vaccination records and medical release forms on file for each child.

MMUMC is exempt from licensure by the State of Georgia because our program meets the maximum of 4 hours per day for 2 days per week. The church carries insurance for all programs and our staff is trained in CPR, First Aid and Safe Sanctuary to provide a fun, safe environment for children.





Your Giving Touches Liberia Have you ever imagined that your giving could save lives half way around the world? This month you have done just that. Through your Faith Promise giving, you have saved the lives of 1,000 children. MMUMC has joined with a mission called LIVE2540 to provide lifesaving medical treatment for malnourished children in a section of Liberia where medical treatment is rare. For \$15, the new hospital built through LIVE2540 can save lives while providing the good news of Jesus Christ for their patients. We praise God for this opportunity to make a difference.

Continuing Help for Flood Victims You may remember that we supported two Certified Emergency Response Teams in the fall which went to help flood victims in Kentucky and Florida. As time passes, the need for help continues, but giving often goes to the latest disaster. UMCOR has now set up a station at Hampton UMC in Jackson, Kentucky to continue the work that was started in that mountain community. Hampton UMC also housed the team that Tamlyn Collins was a part of in the fall. In support of this ongoing mission, our church just donated \$3,415 specifically to help those who are still in trailers. Your giving continues to make a difference. Thank you!

Youth Evangelism Center in Belize Our newest missionary family serves the Caribbean Methodist Churches in Belize. Charles Mulemena serves as Pastor for Libertad and Corazol Methodist Churches and their schools. You may remember that we sent a mission team there last October. While there, the team noticed a building, owned by the church, which was in disrepair. Pastor Charles has the vision to turn it into a youth evangelism center where young people could come for "dinner church" to hear about God and to enjoy learning in small groups. Last month he submitted a proposal for the materials and skilled labor that would be needed to transform the building. Because of your gifts, this vision will be coming true. McEachern is able to fund the entire project! We are hoping to send a team to Belize in mid October to complete any remaining work on the Youth Evangelism Center. Carlos Jose Pirona: Bishop of the Methodist Church of Venezuela, organized in 2007, founder of the Global Restoration Network, Engineer, Rector of the Wesleyan Seminary of Venezuela, and coordinator of the International Leadership Institute, dedicated to teaching and mentoring pastors and planting new churches. With more than 33 years of ministry, family coaching and organizational work in the work of God. Married to Dr. Maria de Pirona and father of three children and happy grandfather of Mía Alegría.

Dr. Maria de Pirona: Pediatrician and Founding Medical Director of

the Wesley Medical Centers, now five Centers in 3 states in Venezuela. The Centers will treat over 25,000 patients in 2023. The Centers employ over 60 health professionals. One new program is *Una Esperanza* treating hundreds of very poor mothers and their babies providing prenatal and postnatal care, nutrition care and teaching them parenting skills. Dr. María is also a pastor and leads dynamic women's ministries in Venezuela.

Both Bishop and Dr. Pirona have earned Bachelor's and Master's degrees in the Seminario Wesleyano de Venezuela and now teach multiple courses in the Seminary.
