MISSIONS

International Leadership Institute (ILI) Your contributions to ILI through Faith Promise gifts continue to bring the good news of Jesus Christ to nations around the world. In 2022, over 25,000 leaders were equipped to lead people to Christ. 114 nations were impacted in Africa, Asia, the Americas and beyond. Teaching happened both online



and in person. In 2023 our church is funding the translation of leadership training materials into the Czech language. We are honored to be a part of this special project coming out of ILI headquarters in Carrolton, Georgia. Please pray for ILI translators as they work diligently to get training materials into 14 new languages.

Evangelist Tom Atkins You might not have heard about our long term partner in a while. Tom has been busy pasturing a church while also traveling from place to place preaching the good news. He was recently seen praying for people at the altar during a large worship service at Norcross UMC. Some weeks before, he was in a small service praying for a woman with tears streaming down her face. Wherever God calls, Tom desires to go, but like the circuit riders of old, Tom depends on the generosity of Christians to get him there. McEachern is one of only a few churches supporting his ministry, and since the circuit rider days, the needs of an evangelist have changed. Recently, Tom was in need of a new laptop as his was broken. He needed a small amount of money to be able to print new brochures about his ministry. 
Youth Evangelism Center in Belize Our newest missionary family serves the Caribbean Methodist Churches in Belize. Charles Mulemena serves as Pastor for both Libertad and Corazol Methodist Churches and their schools. You may remember that we sent a mission team there last October. While there, the team noticed a building, owned by the church, which was in disrepair. Pastor Charles has the vision to turn it into a youth evangelism center where young people can come for an event called "Dinner Church" to hear about God and to enjoy learning in small groups. Last month, he submitted a



proposal for the materials and skilled labor needed to transform the building. Because of your gifts, this vision will become a reality! McEachern is able to fund the entire project! We are hoping to send a team to Belize in mid October to complete any remaining work on the Youth Evangelism Center.
