
The construction will happen every Saturday through September 23 with a dedication target date of October 1. If you are interested

Kairos Prison Ministry



In Matthew 25:34-40, Jesus tells us many ways to serve Him by feeding, clothing, showing hospitality and visiting both the sick and those in prison. At McEachern MUMC, we are often involved in many of these things but visiting in prison is not something we find easy to do. At our church, we have two men and two women who serve in this capacity in a program called Kairos which is similar to *Walk to Emmaus*. We have two weekends a year where we bring

Christ's love and forgiveness to women and men chosen by the prison chaplain. We also return once a month to have prayer, sharing, singing and worship with all the residents who have completed a Kairos weekend. Even though you may not be called to this ministry, there are several ways you can support it. Jane Johnson and I will be serving at Whitworth Women's Facility in Hartwell, GA from September 28 through October 1, 2023. We provide all the meals and supplies for the weekend and for each resident who participates. We can use financial support but most importantly, your prayers. I will be at a table in the Narthex on Sunday, September 10 with a sign-up sheet for those who are willing to help. Please pray about making a commitment to this important ministry. -- Janet Walsh


