MMUMC is exempt from licensure by the State of Georgia because our program meets the maximum of 4 hours per day for 2 days per week. The church carries insurance for all programs and our staff is trained in CPR, First Aid and Safe Sanctuary to provide a fun, safe environment for children.



With all the troubling news in the world, your Mission Lead Team wanted you to have a little good news today. We believe the following items are reasons to celebrate.

- Instead of being in Ukraine where the war rages on, the Korytskyi Family continues to thrive while living in Mission Inn. Myra, the mom, has a birthday this month. (She loves strawberries.)
- Our partner the *Mountain Top Boys Home* received over \$1 Million in donations for the first time this fiscal year. They expanded their mission to serve older boys as well.
- We supported *International Leadership Institute* (Wes and Joy Griffin) as it extended its training for Christian leaders to 115 nations. All of this from Carrollton, Georgia!
- *Circles Cobb* had its first leader meeting to train 10 volunteers to lead groups to help end poverty in our communities.
